"46/35/9/8/2% syrah/savagnin/pinot gris/riesling/prosecco. Fermentation in stainless steel. Interesting multi-dimensional sourcing of grape varieties and regions (Heathcote, Yarra Valley, King Valley and Goulburn Valley) and it all comes together very nicely indeed! Candy-pink hues give an inkling of the bright cherry, raspberry and wild strawberries display across the bouquet. That summer pudding/berry, citrus and floral freshness and intensity is maintained as the wine winds its way with verve to the finish.
