

Grapes: 100% Fiano

Geographical Indication: King Valley, Victoria

The Vineyard: This Fiano was sourced from a vineyard that sits atop the peak of Mt Bellevue at 652m above sea-level in Myrrhee, King Valley. This 20-year-old, high altitude vineyard, was planted on red volcanic loam soils with a north-east aspect.

The Season: The King Valley delivered a textbook growing and ripening season in 2021. Plenty of rain through winter and spring, followed by a mild summer and ideal ripening temperatures produced abundant healthy canopies, lower yields, and slow consistent ripening. A very special vintage.

Winemaking: Fermented in stainless steel to maintain freshness, on fine lees giving complexity and intensity and bottled soon after fermentation to retain the freshness.

Maturation: Stainless steel

Filtration: Crossflow
