"57/43% Yarra Valley pinot noir/ Alpine Valleys pinot gris. A range of winemaking techniques employed here as part of Pacha Mama's experimental (EXP) range. A serious rosé by any reckoning, that brings a sense of intrigue. No one grape is immediately obvious, rather, it's a gradual build of intensity. Wild berries, pear and apple combine with lighter floral elements – rose petal and jasmine – leaving a rosé of spice and texture, fineness and clean acidity with flavour running long."

Salmon-pink in appearance. Lifted aromas of red apple, cherry, dried herbs and citrus rind. Fresh and lively in flavour, crunchy red fruits, tangy acidity and a decent kick of phenolic grip provides texture and a drying mouth-feel.
