**91 points**

**Stuart Knox - The Real Review, 6 February, 2022 - (2020 Vintage)**

A deep ruby hue. Blueberry and black olive tapenade aromatics. Blood plums, black olive and smoked-meat fill the mouth. A full-bodied red that leans into the savoury side of life. Firm sandy tannins control the detail well and it goes quite long into the finish.

Distinctive for its plush, almost creamy frame, offering generous blackberry, black cherry and milk chocolate notes, with toasted cumin, toasted cedar, dried violet and dried candied ginger details on the finish. Drink now through 2036.

Bright, ripe raspberry and red-plum aromas and flavors.

Medium-bodied. Fresh and agile tannins here. Drink now. Screw cap.

Deep ruby colour with some purple on the rim. Charcuterie, blue fruits and violet aromas. Medium to full-weight, slippery front-palate built around an olive and seaspray savoury note. Flows and slides long into the finish. Seamless and rolling. A deliciousness that keeps you returning. Drink 2020 - 2031.

You can't be mistaken on the nose that this is Heathcote Shiraz, there are some reductive charcuterie notes that reveal generous plum that is lifted by dried spices. Plum and dark cherry enjoy supple milk chocolate and work amongst tannins that have impact but are well balanced. Brown spice and undergrowth give definition to drying dark berry fruits to finish.
